

## Everything is easier the longer you do it! Now you have 65 1/2 inches woven!

Insert a row of Cavandoli Knots to finish the weaving and protect your warp. (See instructions from Week 1) before removing your scarf from the loom.

Cut fringe to an even length of about 7 inches. Anchor your scarf on a table or flat surface by putting a heavy book on it that is wider than the scarf. Of each bunch of 4 warp threads, put two in each hand between your thumb and index finger and twist in a clockwise direction at least 10 times or until they kink. Putting the four ends together twist in the other direction. Tie an overhand knot in the tassel working it close to the end using your tapestry needle to keep it loose until it is positioned correctly. Twist the entire tassel in the opposite direction. For best results be very consistent in the amount of twist and the distance of the knot from the end. Trim ends outside of the knot.

Rinse scarf gently in cool water, then block. Some color migration is normal with cotton, so you could rinse several times before the water runs clear. Add 1/8 cup of white vinegar to the last clear rinse. Roll in a towel to remove excess water and lay flat to dry. Do not twist or wring. Use a cool iron to press and block if needed.
